We all love her very much and she will be missed dearly

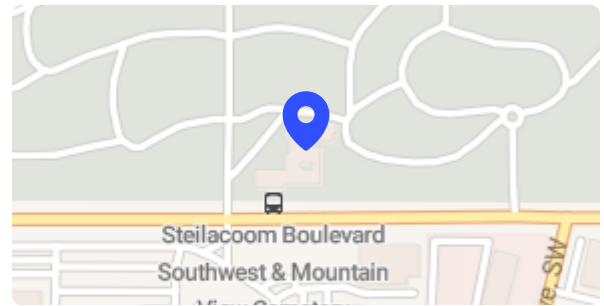

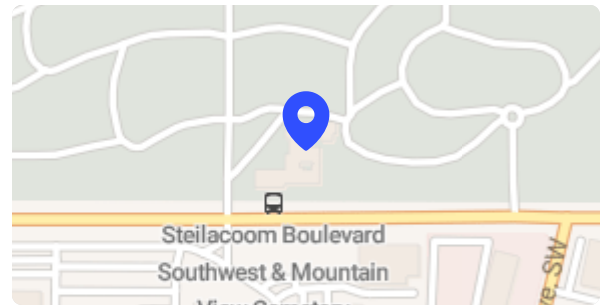

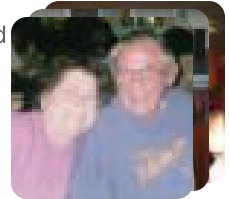
