She was born on January 10, 1925 in Colfax Louisiana to William and Mary (Brew) Glover who preceded her in death along with all of her siblings, and her oldest daughter Annie Lois Blackwell (James).

She is survived by her loving husband Dero Murphy who she was married to for over sixty-seven years.
