Chet Kit Ng, loving husband, father, and grandfather passed away on April 16, 2016 in Renton, Washington. Chet, often went by his nickname Chester, was born on November 11, 1948 in Canton, China. He moved to the United States in the early 1970s. He lived in Tacoma for over 25 years before moving to Renton in 2002.

Chester first worked as a cook at his uncle's restaurant, the Golden City in Tacoma for many years before opening his own restaurant, Canton Cafe, with his wife Mei. This was a business the whole family participated in for 16 years. Chester also worked for the U.S. Post Office, and most recently the Federal Way School District and Muckleshoot Casino. He was well regarded by all his coworkers and called many of them his friends.

Chester was a highly regarded member of the Eng Association for many years and has served as President and Vice President of the Association. He enjoyed his duties at the Association which allowed him to travel, network, and even meet the current President of China, Xi Jinping. This past November, while serving his duties with the Association, he made a trip home to his birth place of China, which he had not been to in over 40 years. It was a very special trip for him.

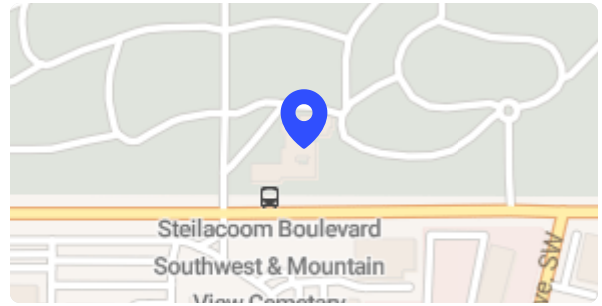
