Survived by his beloved wife and partner Ely, blessed in the sacrament of marriage for seventy-one years. Preceded into the Lord's hands by sons Danilo, age sixty-seven; Raphael at infancy; and grandson Shawn age thirty-one. Survived by children Ernesto, Lorna, Rowena, Renato, Adora, Noel, and Melvin.

I met SFC Dan Figuracion through my father who was also a US Army Philippine Scout. Dan has a unique smile and very friendly. He was instrumental in giving me a chance to reactivate the Capt. Jose Calugas, Sr. chapter of the Philippine Scouts Heritage Society(PSHS). website: www.philippine-scouts.org.The chapter named after my father, who was the only Filipino recipient of the Congressional Medal of Honor during WWII in Bataan, Philippines also buried in Mountain View Cemetery.Dan was with the 26th cavalry US Army Philippine scout during WWII. He participated in the last cavalry charge on horseback at the battle in Morong, Bataan Philippines. He was captured by the Japanese and was forced to March 65 miles, called the Bataan Death March and eventually a POW at Capas,Tarlac.I am glad to know him over the years and very active in supporting the Philippine Scouts Heritage Society whose goal is to preserve the history, heritage and legacy of the Philippine Scouts. My prayers and sympathy to Dan's family , wife Ely, his children and grandchildren and great grandchildren. He is in good hands with Almighty.Love,Joe and Goody Calugas
