Maggie Walker, 74 of Tacoma, passed away January 1, 2018. She died peacefully in her sleep after a battle with breast cancer.

Maggie was born July 31, 1943 in Birmingham Alabama. Her parents Milton Pace and Susan Barnett Pace named her Lloyd LaVan, but her family and friends called her Maggie.

Maggie and her husband Raymond raised 5 children and one grandchild. She worked as a secretary for the state of Oregon for several years. She attended college and studied social work but did not complete the last few credits she needed to graduate.

Maggie enjoyed traveling and taking her grandchildren on trips when they graduated high school. She has been to England, Ireland, Scotland, and Egypt among other places.

Maggie is preceded in death by her parents, her brothers Victor and Shirley Pace, her husband Raymond, son Raymond Walker Junior, and daughter Rebecca Etherington. 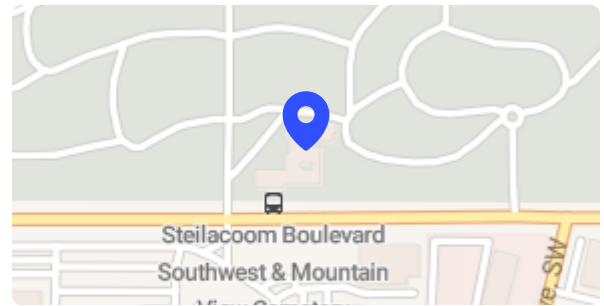

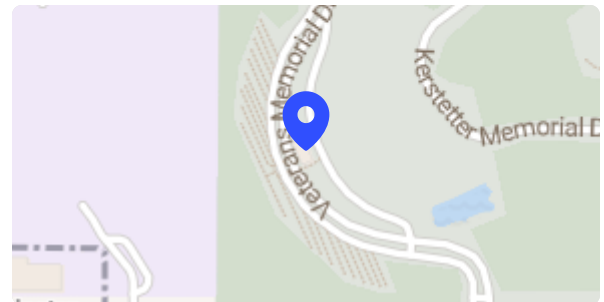
