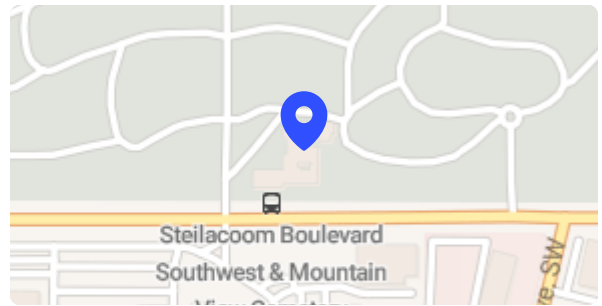
MAY 27, 1975 - DEC 21, 2018
