Now may God rest your soul. We'll miss your physical face, but never miss your spirit.

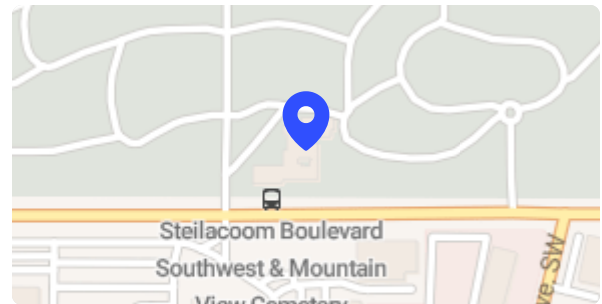
