Soon Cha Kezele

AUG 5, 1951 - JUN 22, 2023

Soon Cha Kezele, age 71, passed away on June 22nd, 2023 after a courageous battle with cancer. She was born in 1951 amid the Korean War in Kyonggi-do, South Korea. She and her three siblings worked on the farm they were raised on, and walked three miles each way to attend primary school.

As a young woman, Soon moved to Itaewon near the U.S. Army base where she met her future husband Andrew. Despite not speaking English, she was determined to learn, and almost a year after meeting, the two were married. Over the next 15 years, the military stationed them in Arizona, Oklahoma, and Germany. During this time, their first child Wayne was born in 1977, followed by Jessica in 1990. In 1992, the family permanently relocated to Washington.

Soon thrived in the Pacific Northwest and became an integral part of several communities. She lovingly served her church for the last 30 years, where she eventually became a deaconess. Soon continued to serve others by selflessly working as a caregiver for nearly 20 years. In her spare time, she was focused not only on her service to the church and her community, but also her continued personal growth. She enjoyed learning to play the piano, taking computer classes, and started working with Atomy as a sales consultant.

When she wasn't working, she enjoyed visiting botanical gardens, traveling with her family, catching up on Korean dramas, frequenting any buffet that included crab legs, and documenting all of it through photos she took on her phone. She leaves her loved ones with unforgettable memories, stories, and thousands of photos. Soon devoted herself to the well-being of everyone around her until the end, when she had nothing left to give and the Lord called her to Heaven. Her faith, strength, compassion, and perseverance were felt by everyone who knew and loved her, and she will be deeply missed. She is survived by her husband and their two children.

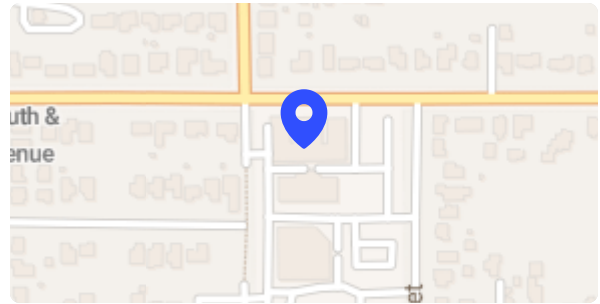
