Marietta Jean (Hein) Miller passed away peacefully on November 7th 2024 at Good Samaritan Hospital in Puyallup, Washington surrounded by her close and loving family. Marietta was 102 years young at her passing. She was a long time resident of Spanaway, Washington where she built her dream home. Marietta was born in Durham, Marion County, Kansas on July 29th 1922. Marietta was the third child of three from parents Daniel Edward Hein and Hannah Joan Schlotthauer. 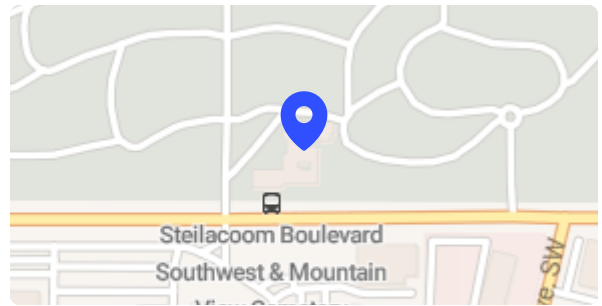

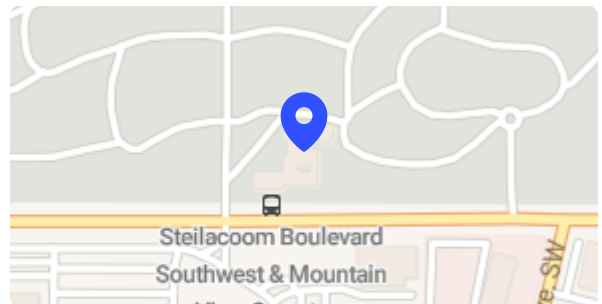
