Edgar is survived by his loving wife, Karla and friends who will remember him with respect and appreciation for the life he lived.

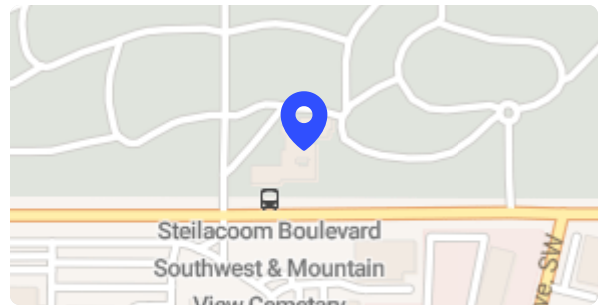

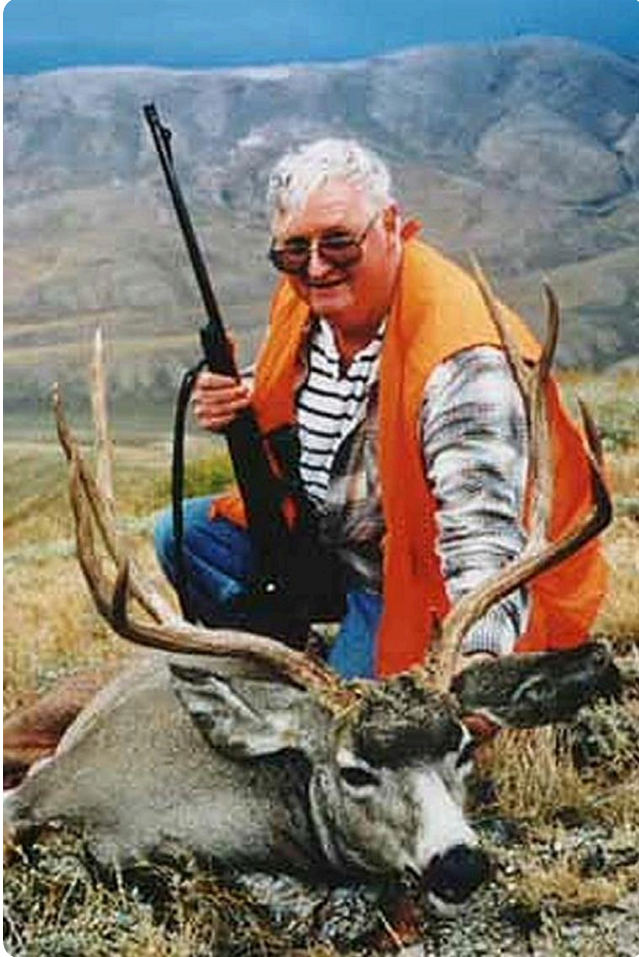
