Inez was born February 12, 1912 to Anna & Martin Ulseth in a farm house twelve miles south of Crookston, MN. She had two older brothers, Edgar and Melvin, and two older sisters Clair and Ora. In 1941, the family moved to Tacoma, WA where she worked at Buffelens Plywood Company for 25 years. She met Ed Hansch in 1965 shortly after Ed's wife passed away. They were married on July 1, 1966. Inez quit her job at Buffelens while Ed kept working until retirement. They mowed lawns for friends and neighbors, and provided taxi service to and from their church. They resided in Tacoma on 54th Street until moving to People's Retirement Home in 1992. Ed passed away July 29, 1997. Inez is survived by Ora Molskness, her sister, nieces and nephews, step daughter Dorothy Barefield, also step grandchildren Bill Olsen, Michael Hansch, Ed Hansch, Bill & Celinda Barefield, David & Geri Barefield, and several great-step-grandchildren.
