Survivors include sons, Tom and Anthony aka "Stony," of Lakewood; three brothers, Bob of Hawaii, and Jack and Leonard of Ohio; a sister, Vita of Florida; and many nieces and nephews. Thomas Morrella Jr. served 22 years in the United States Army, serving two tours in Vietnam. After retirement he owned and operated a security company. A funeral service will be held at Noon, Friday, March 4, 2005, at the Mt. View Valley Chapel. Visitation will be held one hour before services in the chapel.
