He was a WWII decorated veteran and retired from the U.S. Air Force in 1966. A parishioner at St. Mary's Episcopal Church, Jack played guitar in the Kairos Prison Ministry for many years. In his peaceful passing, he joins his children Timothy and Deborah, his siblings Bill and Betty, and his parents Ben and Ruth.
