Gary C. Cleveland After a courageous five-year battle with pancreatic cancer, Gary went home to be with his Lord on April 27, 2008. After serving for three years in the Army, he married his wife of 45 years, Arden (Tremblay) Cleveland, on Sept. 14, 1962.
