Ardelle 'Linda' Marin passed away peacefully at her home in Lacey on December 9, 2009, at the age of 84, with her daughter Cindy, granddaughter Tammy and great granddaughter Jennie by her side. The second child of Dudley and Esther Davies, 'Linda' was born in Tacoma, WA, on October 5, 1925. Linda grew up and lived in Tacoma until she met her future husband Fredrick H. Marin of Newark, Ohio, in 1942. They were married in January of 1944. During their early years of marriage Fred and Linda traveled to various locations in the US because of Fred's employment with the Civil Service.
