## Wallace Condiff

JUN 2, 1923 - MAR 17, 2013

**W**ally was born on June 2, 1923 to Charlie and Grace Condiff or Park Rapids, Minnesota. Following graduation from Park Rapids High Scholl in June of 1941, he traveled to Tacoma, Washington where he worked in the shipyard as a sheet metal worker. On November 13th, 1942 Wally enlisted in the U.S. Army. Upon completing basic training, training, he was sent to England where he was attached to the 90th Infantry Division. Wall went ashore in the d-day invasion at Normandy and was awarded the Bronze Star for bravery in action. He received an honorable discharge from the U.S. Army on December 21, 1945, and returned to Tacoma. He secured a Job with the United States Postal Service on January 1, 1956, and continued as a mail carrier for the next 35 years. He married his wife Maria KPM July 29, 1958, and last year they celebrated their 52nd wedding anniversary. After retirement, Wally continued to serve his community by volunteering for the past 12 years at the Light House Senior Activity Center in Tacoma.
