He entered the U.S. Army in 1944. During the European theater of World War II, he served in the Artillery Division. In Trieste, Italy, Charles met the love his life Miranda, and spent the next 69 years together. Continuing this career in the U.S. Army, resulted in two tours in Vietnam as a helicopter mechanic.
